

An Ordinance to Adopt the Town of Adams Comprehensive Plan

Ordinance No. 7-31-2005

An Ordinance to Adopt the Comprehensive Plan of the Town of Adams, Wisconsin.

The Town Board of the Town of Adams, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to section 62.23(2) and(3), for cities, villages, and towns exercising village powers under 60.22(3) of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Town of Adams, is authorized to prepare and adopt a comprehensive plan as defined in section 66.1001(1)(a) and 66.1001(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 2. The Town Board of the Town of Adams, Wisconsin, has adopted written procedures designed to foster public participation in the preparation of a comprehensive plan as required by section 66.101(4)(a) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 3. The plan commission of the Town of Adams, by majority vote of the entire commission recorded in its official minutes, has adopted a resolution recommending to the Town Board the adoption of the document entitled "Town of Adams Comprehensive Plan" containing all the elements specified in section 66.1001(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 4. The Town has held at least one public hearing on this ordinance, in compliance with the requirements of section 66.1001(4)(d) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 5. The Town Board of the Town of Adams, Wisconsin, does by enactment of this ordinance, formally adopt the document entitled, "Town of Adams Comprehensive Plan" pursuant to sections 66.1001(4)(c) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect on Sept. 12, 2005 upon passage by a majority vote of the members-elect of the Town Board and posted as required by law.
