

An Ordinance to Adopt the Village of Browntown Comprehensive Plan

Ordinance No. 2005-01

An Ordinance to Adopt the Comprehensive Plan of the Village of Browntown, Wisconsin.

The Village Board of the Village of Browntown, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to section 62.23(2) and (3), for cities, villages, and towns exercising village powers under 60.22(3) of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Village of Browntown, is authorized to prepare and adopt a comprehensive plan as defined in section 66.1001(1)(a) and 66.1001(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 2. The Village Board of the Village of Browntown, Wisconsin, has adopted written procedures designed to foster public participation in the preparation of a comprehensive plan as required by section 66.1001(4)(a) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 3. The plan commission of the Village of Browntown, by a majority vote of the entire commission recorded in its official minutes, has adopted a resolution recommending to the Village Board the adoption of the document entitled "Village of Browntown Comprehensive Plan" containing all of the elements specified in section 66.1001(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 4. The Village has held at least one public hearing on this ordinance, in compliance with the requirements of section 66.1001(4)(d) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 5. The Village Board of the Village of Browntown, Wisconsin, does, by enactment of this ordinance, formally adopt the document entitled, "Village of Browntown Comprehensive Plan" pursuant to section 66.1001(4)(c) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect on 11 OCT 2005 (insert date) upon passage by a majority vote of the members-elect of the Village Board and posted as required by law.
