

VILLAGE OF NEW GLARUS
Ordinance 05-10

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT
THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW GLARUS, WISCONSIN

THE VILLAGE BOARD of the VILLAGE OF NEW GLARUS, GREEN COUNTY, WISCONSIN, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to section 62.23(2) and (3), for cities, villages, and towns exercising village powers under 60.22(3) of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Village of New Glarus, is authorized to prepare and adopt a comprehensive plan as defined in section 66.1001(1)(a) and 66.1001(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 2. The Village Board of the Village of New Glarus, Wisconsin, has adopted written procedures designed to foster public participation in the preparation of a comprehensive plan as required by section 66.1001(4)(a) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 3. The plan commission of the Village of New Glarus, by a majority vote of the entire commission recorded in its official minutes, has adopted a resolution recommending to the Village Board the adoption of the document entitled "Village of New Glarus Comprehensive Plan" containing all of the elements specified in section 66.1001(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 4. The Village has held at least one public hearing on this ordinance, in compliance with the requirements of section 66.1001(4)(d) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 5. The Village Board of the Village of New Glarus, Wisconsin, does, by enactment of this ordinance, formally adopt the document entitled, "Village of New Glarus Comprehensive Plan" pursuant to section 66.1001(4)(c) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect on December 20, 2005 upon passage by a majority vote of the members-elect of the Village Board and publication as required by law.
