**WHEREAS**, the State of Wisconsin enacted new legislation 59.69(3) and 66.1001, Wis. Stats., October 27, 1999 mandating local governmental units and counties to adopt a comprehensive plan by January 1, 2010,




**WHEREAS**, Lafayette County was awarded in the competitive grant process \$258,000 toward the completion of said plan and its nine (9) elements as required by law,


