

**Town of Wiota
Ordinance 2007-2**

Relating to Adopting the Town of Wiota Comprehensive Plan

The Town Board of the Town of Wiota, Lafayette County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to ss. 60.22(3) and 62.23(2) and (3), Wis. Stats., the Town of Wiota is authorized to prepare and adopt a comprehensive plan as defined in s. 66.1001(1)(a) and (2), Wis. Stats.

Section 2. The Town of Wiota, through the Town of Wiota Plan Commission, has adopted written procedures designed to foster public participation in the preparation of a comprehensive plan as required by s. 66.1001(4)(a), Wis. Stats.

Section 3. The Town of Wiota Plan Commission, by majority vote of the entire Commission, as recorded in its official minutes, has adopted a resolution recommending to the Town Board the adoption of the document entitled "Town of Wiota Comprehensive Plan" containing all of the elements specified in s. 66.1001(2), Wis. Stats.


Section 4. The Town has held a public hearing on the plan and this ordinance, in compliance with s. 66.1001(4)(d), Wis. Stats.


Section 5. The Town Board of the Town of Wiota, by enactment of this ordinance, does formally adopt the document entitled "Town of Wiota Comprehensive Plan", pursuant to s. 66.1001(4)(c), Wis. Stats.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect the day after the date of publication or posting as provided by s.60.80, Wis. Stats.
