

Ordinance to adopt the Town of Eagle Comprehensive Plan
Ordinance No. 2006-8

An Ordinance to Adopt the Comprehensive Plan of the Town of Eagle, Wisconsin.

The Town Board of Eagle, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to Section 62.23(2) and (3), for cities, villages, and towns exercising village powers under 60.22(3) of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Town of Eagle, is authorized to prepare and adopt a comprehensive plan as defined in Section 66.1001(1)(a) and 66.1001(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 2. The Town Board of the Town of Eagle, Wisconsin has adopted written procedures designed to foster public participation in the preparation of a comprehensive plan as required by Section 66.1001(4)(a) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 3. The Plan Commission of the Town of Eagle, by a majority vote of the entire commission recorded in its official minutes, has adopted a resolution recommending to the Town Board the adoption of the document entitled "Town of Eagle Comprehensive Plan" containing all of the elements specified in Section 66.1001(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 4. The Town has held at least one public hearing on this ordinance, in compliance with the requirements of Section 66.1001(4)(d) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 5. The Town Board of the Town of Eagle, Wisconsin, does, by this ordinance, formally adopts the document entitled "Town of Eagle Comprehensive Plan" pursuant to Section 66.1001(4)(c) of the Wisconsin Statutes.


Section 6. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and posting as required by law.

Approved and adopted by the Eagle Town Board on a vote of 3 to 0 this 14th day of September, 2006.




